You will have:

Essential

- Full Stack development skills, ideally with experience with Java, Spring Boot and Hibernate.
- Front-end skills (VueJs preferred, but React or Angular are also valuable)
- Experience with microservices, APIs, SSO, Docker, DevOps, and AWS (or other cloud providers) is a plus.
- Well-developed knowledge of Atlassian BitBucket (or other git-based source repositories, flows, branching practices, etc)
- Proven ability using TDD with JUnit, Selenium and other testing frameworks
- Strong project planning, time management and organisation skills
- Experience using Postgres or other relational databases
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills, including high-level interpersonal skills

Highly Desirable

- The ability to refine the scope and specific requirements of a task or epic into deliverables and testable user stories.
- Participated in planning and decision-making, and other tasks as required.
- Worked with your team, business analysts and project leader to understand the requirements of any new features.
- Experience using agile development methods, and Jira to facilitate.
- Experience working with stakeholders to prioritise new features alongside other commitments, including bug fixes, and small enhancements and improvements.
- Flexibility in thinking and coping with multiple and changing priorities
- Experience with performance testing and peer testing of code.
